

Trinity Vestry Meeting Summary

December 2024

The Vestry of Trinity Church met on Tuesday evening, December 17, at the home of the Reverend Dr. Scott White and Missy Sherburne for a short business meeting, followed by a wonderful social gathering. A quorum was present, and nobody joined electronically.

The minutes of the November Vestry meeting were approved, and the Vestry said thank you for the retiring class of 2024, Nancy Dexter, Jennifer Pearson, Matt Sharp, Ralph Simpson, and Connie Wilson. The Vestry then welcomed the class of 2027, newly elected: Anne Bleynat, Mark Daddona, Eleveve Donahue, Peyton Evert, and Mike Smith.

The rector then recommended that Nancy Dexter fill James Bradley's unexpired term. The motion passed unanimously.

The Rev. Dr. Scott White recommended to the Vestry that Tom Williams serve as Senior Warden for 2025 and Nancy Dexter as Junior Warden. The motion passed unanimously.

The financial director, Jan Hildebrand, presented the financial reports for the year 2024 through November.

Trinity's Finance Team proposed a 2025 budget of \$1,510,000. The budget was approved unanimously.

The Rev. Dr. Scott White reviewed the Christmas services schedule and briefly discussed the upcoming Vestry Retreat on January 11th and 12th. He also reported that Jeff Cook will continue as the Director of operations.

The formal meeting adjourned, and the Vestry continued with holiday cheer.
