## Vestry Meeting Summary | October 2023

The Vestry of Trinity Episcopal Church met in person and by Zoom on October 17, 2023, at 5:30p.

The Rev. Scott White opened with prayer requests and prayer. He thanked everyone for participating at Trinity's annual meeting this past Sunday.

The consent agenda was approved.

In the absence of Financial Director Jan Hildebrand, Treasurer Jennifer Weidemann reported on the September financials. Revenue continues to carry a surplus over expenses.

The Rev. Amy Peterson reported that the End of Life dinner series has been well attended, and book clubs are growing in attendance. Plans are being made for a group of teens to go to Greece next summer.

Discernment continues with Trinity Place and The Children's Hope Alliance.

Doug Scothorn provided a COVID update. He emphasized the importance of continuing to follow the CDC's recommendations.

Discernment continues searching for a qualified candidate for The Church of the Advocate Vicar and Trinity Assistant Rector position.

Trinity's internet service will be upgraded to Charter Fiber, improving the live streaming of worship services.

Senior Warden, Katherine Ray, shared that she attended a presentation by the Creation Care Committee and was impressed with the work they are doing to help Trinity become a better steward of the environment.

The Vestry continued with off-the-record time, then moved to Executive Session.
